

COLUMBARIUM LICENSE

This LICENSE is issued as of ____ day of _____, 19__ by the Bishop of Charleston, a Corporation Sole hereinafter referred to as "The Bishop") acting through the Pastor or Administrator of its Parish, Precious Blood of Christ Catholic Church, Pawleys Island, South Carolina (hereinafter referred to as "The Parish") to: (Please print)

hereinafter referred to as the "Licensee").

WHEREAS with the authority of the Bishop the Parish has undertaken the construction of a Columbarium to provide a reverential place to inter the cremated remains of Eligible Person(s) as defined by the Columbarium Rules and Regulations in perpetuity in a memorial garden setting and

WHEREAS the Columbarium will be constructed in phases as demand indicates; and

WHEREAS the Bishop through the Pastor or Administrator of the Parish agrees to issue this License; and

WHEREAS the Licensee desires to acquire the privilege of interment in the Columbarium of the cremated remains of the Eligible Person(s); and

WHEREAS the Licensee has designated such persons and agrees to the terms and conditions of the following License which are to be binding upon and inures to the benefit of the Licensee and all Eligible person(s);

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1.0 The Bishop licenses one niche in the Columbarium to the Licensee subject to the following terms, limitations and conditions:
 - 1.1 No property right of any kind in the Columbarium or any part accrues to the benefit of the Licensee or Eligible Person(s). This License extends solely to the privilege of interment of the cremated remains of Eligible Person(s) designated below, in the Columbarium, subject always to the attached Columbarium Rules and Regulations and to all future reasonable and uniform amendments which may be hereafter adopted by the Bishop without notice.
 - 1.2 This License is subject to any applicable usage, rules and discipline of the Roman Catholic Church now or hereafter in effect as well as the requirements of the Bishop.
 - 1.3 The Licensee also understands that the plans for the Columbarium exhibited to the members of the Parish are conceptual only, and that the Columbarium will be constructed in phases over a period of years depending upon the funds that become available and the extent of the demand for niches. Neither the Bishop nor the Parish make any representations as to the nature and extent of future construction.
- 2.0 The Bishop acknowledges the receipt of \$_____ as a fee for the above License. At the time of the interment of cremated remains in the Columbarium, NO additional fees will be assessed for opening the Niche and for the manufacture and installation of a standard memorial cover.
- 3.0 This License is issued to the Licensee personally and is intended to extend only to Eligible Person(s) designated below. The Columbarium Rules and Regulations limit the privilege of transferring a License.
- 4.0 This License may be terminated:
 - 4.1 By voluntary surrender by the Licensee prior to interment as provided in the Columbarium Rules and Regulations.
 - 4.2 Under the provisions of the Columbarium Rules and Regulations.

- 5.0 The Bishop through its Parish intends to exercise reasonable care in the routine maintenance of the Columbarium in perpetuity. In the event of injury, loss or damage to the Columbarium or its constituent parts, the liability of the Bishop and/or the Parish is limited to the cost of repair or replacement. The Bishop and/or the Parish is not responsible for the loss of cremated remains deposited in the Columbarium.
- 6.0 If, at the discretion of the Bishop it become necessary or desirable to change the location of the Columbarium, or to discontinue the use of any part, the Bishop, at his expense, may have the urns and cremated remains removed and preserved in another suitable place.
- 7.0 The following terms shall have the following meanings when used in this License:
- 7.1 Eligible Person(s): those persons eligible for the privilege of having their cremated remains interred in the Columbarium as defined by the Columbarium Rules and Regulations.
 - 7.2 Niche: a recess in the Unit for holding up to two Urns.
 - 7.3 Urn: a suitable receptacle for cremated remains to be place in a Niche.
 - 7.4 Interment: the placement of an Urn contained cremated remains into a Niche.
- 8.0 The Licensee designates the following Eligible Person(s):
